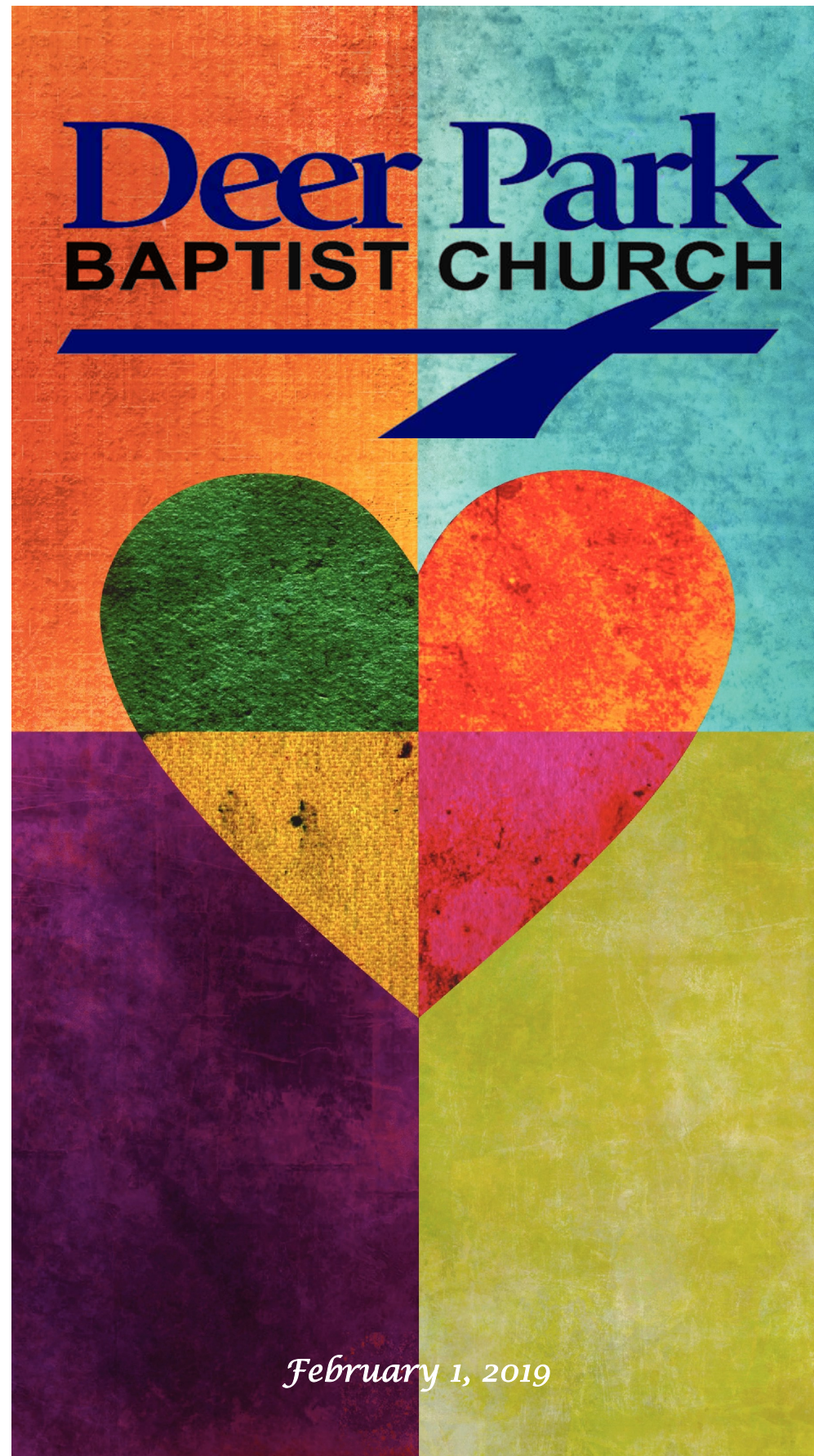

From Your Pastor

Over the past month, my sermons have focused on “Spiritual Formation” which is the process of living more and more like Jesus. One area of emphasis that I have enjoyed studying is worship. There are varying definitions of worship, and the one that I use most often is “expressing my love to God.” Expressing my love to God happens in my time alone with Him and it happens as we gather together on Sunday morning and express our love to God as a church family.

One of my prayers is that when we gather together for worship, we will focus on the One that we have come to worship and not on ourselves. In our culture, there seems to be a mindset that worship is somehow about me, me being the individual (what I want, what I believe, what I desire, what I will receive) when it is really all about Jesus. My prayer for you and for me is that we will not worship “worship” (the process and order) but that we will worship Jesus. I pray that when you and I come together for worship, that our only expectation will be to encounter the presence of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This should be your expectation in your time alone with God and in your time of worship with your church family.

I am currently reading a book about the life of William Wilberforce, who led the movement to abolish slavery in Great Britain. Wilberforce worked tirelessly to end slavery but met defeat at almost every turn. Following one disheartening defeat, he thought, “Perhaps he had come face-to-face with what John Wesley had warned of, with the evilness of evil.” I mention this because this is how I feel about the abortion debate in our country today. As I see people celebrating laws being passed to further widen the scope of abortion, up until birth, I think of those words, that perhaps we are coming face-to-face with the evilness of evil.

What seemed an insurmountable task given to Wilberforce was not, he is remembered today for his contribution to slavery being abolished in 1807. We have before us in America, what seems to be the insurmountable duty of protecting the life of the unborn. The duty that we have to protect the life of the unborn is not insurmountable, it can be accomplished with God’s help and with God’s strength, if we do not grow weary and if we do not give up. Maybe you or I are to champion this movement in our time, just as Wilberforce championed the movement to abolish slavery in his time.

I pray that you and I will walk with the Lord in such a way that His light will shine through us to a world that desperately needs to see it.
